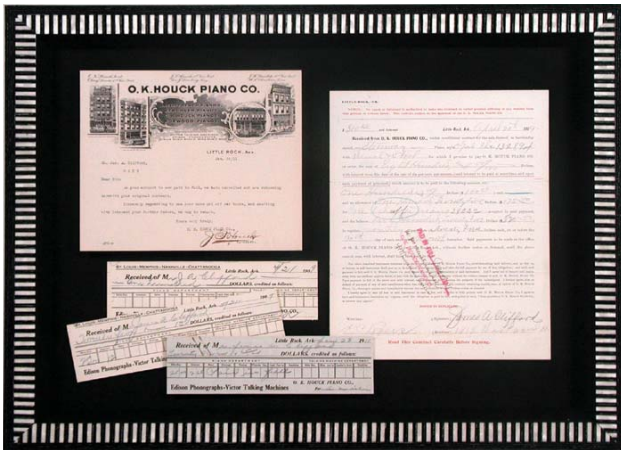

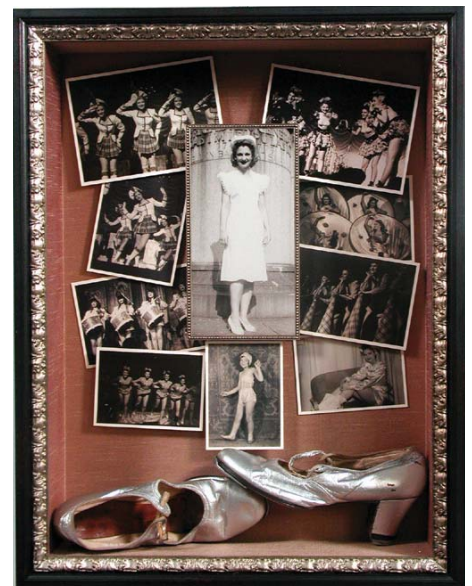


Mother's Day...

Sgraffitto Bradley's Back Room by Jennifer Robey

It is said that the frame is the reward of the artist. In fact, the frame itself can be a work of art. Some framemakers still hold to the old traditions of creating frames by painstakingly handcrafting each piece. One of the special artist embellishments is referred to as Sgraffitto. This technique involves "Scratching" a decoration into a painted panel on a frame. First the frame is hand gilded (which involves many steps & is extremely time consuming). The surface that is to have the Sgraffitto is then hand painted with a special type of paint. Once the paint is dried, the framemaker then transfers a design (often one of their own creations) onto the painted panel. Using a special tool, the framemaker carefully scratches out the design revealing the luminous gold underneath. The result is a dramatic & beautiful design that reflects the old world traditions that are still in use today.
