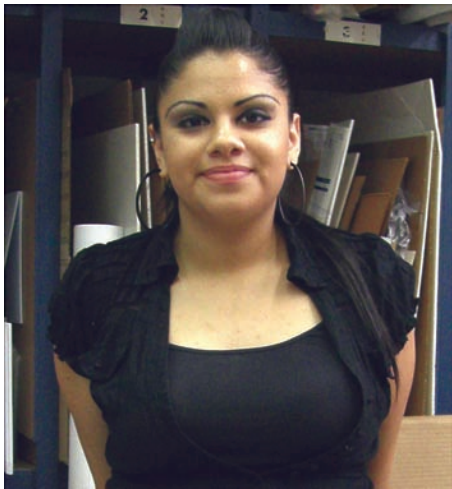
Spring Woods at MAM Summer Intern Program
